Henry M. Balls former, Samuel Dudley, Eben C. Wells, Russell Norritt, John Stephenson, John M. Long, Dennis Turner, Warren Edwards, George Moxie, William Edwards, William Sackford, William Ayers, James Luskens, Dempsey Stewart, John A. Long and Lewis Skiff were sworn a grand jury of request for the body of this County and having received their charge withdrew and after sometime returned into Court and presented Anthony M. Howell former in the County of Southampton for selling certain goods to Henry Croft negro without a permit from the said Henry Croft, and purchasing certain eggs from the same without a permit, within the last twelve months upon the evidence of Edward Edwards sworn in Court and sent to the grand jury.

Anthony M. Howell former in the County of Southampton for selling certain goods to Jordan Edwards negro without permission from him and purchasing chickens and eggs from the same without permission within the last twelve months upon the evidence of Edward Edwards sworn in Court and sent for the grand jury. And the said grand jury having nothing further to present were discharged.

Ordered that Anthony M. Howell be summoned to the next quarterly Court then term, if any be and why Informations should not be filed against him upon the presentments of the grand jury this day made against him.

The order of reference made in this case not being performed at the instance of the plaintiff by his attorney it is ordered that the same be set aside and that the cause be remanded upon the Docket to be tried by a jury in like manner as if the said order had never been made.

On the motion of William J. Schell executor of Nicholas M. Schell deceased against Mary A. White guardian of the persons of William White deceased for counter security. This day came the parties by their attorneys who being fully heard. It is ordered that the said Mary A. White give the said Schell counter or affirmative good counter security according to law the bond for which purpose is to be in the penalty of two thousand dollars and conditioned as the law directs and that she pay the costs of this motion. And thereupon the said Mary A. White appearing in Court and offering to give the said security it is ordered that her duties and powers as guardian as aforesaid be revoked and annulled.

The Court doth assign Mary A. White guardian of William A. and John A. White nephews of William White deceased and thereupon the said Mary A. White with Harrison D. Moore and Sarah Mary her securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned according to law.
