This day this cause was docketed by Court and cause of parties and amounts to be heard next bill and answer and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Thomas B. Norwell, Benjamin J. Norwell and Everett J. Hill be appointed Commissioners (any two of whom may act) and that they be authorized after advertising the time and place of sale in two or more public places in the County for thirty days, to sell to the highest bidder, at public auction, the tract of twenty nine and one half acres of land late the property of Allen Hill dec'd except the taxes following back, they not to receive in hand on the day of sale, money sufficient to pay the costs of this cause. For the balance of the purchase money a credit of six months may be allowed, to buyer which they are to take of the purchaser six tracts of equal amounts with good security and agrees as follows, one to James T. Hill and Margaret Hill, three to Henry H. Hill as guardian of Norwell B. Edith & R. and Martha P. Hill and the ninth or remaining tract agrees to the grantland of the two children of Sally Edwards dec'd and report to the Court in order to a final decree.
