Shadrack a negro man slave the property of Allen Stephens of this County who has been
committed to the jail of this County charged with having on the 10th day of September 1818 feloniously
killed and murdered Joe Shipp a free negro in this County, was the day set to the law in custody of
the keeper of the Jail of this County and being arraigned pleaded not guilty. Whereupon divers witness
were sworn and examined and the prisoner was fully tried in his defense by Counsel. On consideration
whereof it is the opinion of the Court that the prisoner is not guilty of the murder as charged but
that he is guilty of voluntary manslaughter. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the
prisoner receive twenty lashes on his bare back well laid on at the public whipping post, and
that the Sheriff cause execution to be done forthwith and then discharge the prisoner from custody -
