Moore, William J. Moore, Dorely B. Moore, Mary J. Moore, James O. Moore and Warren Edwards for life and equal to the Court an order to a final decree.

On the motion of Miles Merrill ordered that the Clerk of this Court return to the said the bonds filed in this suit due him as guardian of the persons of J. H. Merrill dec'd.

On the motion of Anthony Woodard a legatee of the estate of Mary Jones dec'd. It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the order made at July Court 1842 has been published for eight weeks in one of the newspapers published in the Town of Petersburg and posted at the front door of the Court house of this County on two successive Court days, and that the creditors have presented their claims against the estate of Mary Jones. Therefore the Court doth adjudge order and decree that Nathan Thomas executor of Nathaniel Jones who was executor of Mary Jones do pay to Anthony Woodard and Sally his wife the sum of one hundred and twenty three dollars and twenty cents with interest thereon from the 1st day of December 1842 until paid, and that he and his wife shall not be required to give to the said Nathaniel Jones any bond or security requiring them to refund the said money in case there should be a deficiency of assets to pay the debts owing by Mary Jones deceased.
