After the above was arranged and settled as reported it was ordered by the Court as fr. annexed deors that J. Jas. W. Mungif Court should pay J. Co. Langston debt and costs, of forty seven dollars and 51 cents, and clerk fee of 97^{cts}. Whereupon Susan Mungif refunded of her portion eighty dollars and sixteen cents and paid on each of the bonds sixteen dollars and sixteen cents making 362.58

Subsequently at June Court 1827 it was ordered that J. Jas. W. Mungif Court should pay my claim duly authenticated. And it has been deors as fr. annexed deors that I should pay J. Co. Langston's claim & costs. Whereupon on the 8th day of May 1828 Susan Mungif paid upon each note twenty six dollars and 51 cents and refunded of her as fr. first deors the only ten dollars and 51 cents making eighty dollars and forty three cents to pay the following claims. And on 17th July 1828 Susan Mungif paid upon upon each note fourteen dollars and four and one third cents and refunded of her portion as fr. the first deors the same and \$18.52^{cts} making \$42.16 to pay J. Co. Langston's claim. Whereupon J. Jas. W. Mungif Court paid the said \$23.17
