The Commissioners in this case this day made their report which is in these words to wit - In relation to a tract of the amercable County Court of Southampton bearing date March 1<sup>st</sup> 1797 and heretofore annexed, we the undersigned Commissioners have proceeded to divide the slaves of which John Williamson died possessed and have found them agreeably to the valuation set on them to be worth £900 one tenth of which is £90. We have therefore allotted to Pitts agreeably to the decree as her one tenth part of the said slaves one slave being valued by Black rubel at £75 and one woman & boy valued at £25 - making £100. We have also in further obedience to the direction of the said decree allotted to John Williamson (the balance of the said slaves being allotted to John Denney, John S. Morris, Abingdon, Margaret Theodore Sarah Peter, Deborah English, Dick Brown, Lewis, Constantine, Martha, Judy, Georgina, Eliza, Malinda, Elizabeth, Nelly, Anna, Lucy,
