

custody of the Jailor of this County and being arraigned of the premises pleaded not guilty Whereupon sundry witnesses being sworn and examined and the prisoner by his counsel fully heard - The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances considered is of opinion that the prisoner is guilty of perjury Therefore it is considered by the Court that the prisoner be imprisoned in the Jail of this County for the term of thirty days from this day and that he receive thirty nine lashes in his bare back well laid on at the public whipping post in and out and thirty nine lashes immediately preceding his discharge And it is ordered that the Sheriff cause execution of this judgment to be done - And afterwards the prisoner is remanded to jail -

The Commissioners in this cause this day made their report which is in these words to wit.
"Accordingly to a decree of the County Court of Southampton dated January Term 1848 We the undersigned Commissioners expressed in said decree, in obedience to the requisitions thereof have laid off the dower of Henry S Williams' widow and Eldridge Williams' widow in the land of said Eldridge Williams, being attended by Thomas B Worrell surveyor, who surveyed the same and found there to be in the whole tract six hundred and eighty five acres - of which we have allotted to Henry S Williams widow two hundred and sixty seven acres, as her dower in said land, which is bounded as follows. Beginning at a sweet gum in Davis Bryants line, a new corner for the said widows, thence along a new line of marked West 109 poles to a post on the path, a new corner for said Eldridge Williams' widow thence same course 12 1/2 poles to a sower wood, a new corner in said Davis Bryants line, thence along line to John Jenkins' line, thence along said Jenkins' line to said Davis Bryants (Hardy line) thence along the line to the beginning - We have also allotted to Eldridge Williams' widow one hundred and forty acres, as her dower in said land, including the houses, which is bounded as follows, Beginning at the same Sweet gum in Davis Bryants line, thence along the other widows line West 109 poles to a post on the path, a new corner, thence S. 14. E 247 poles to the run of Rochelles Mill swamp, thence down the run of said Swamp to Davis Bryants corner, thence along his line to the beginning - We have also shown a plot of the land - Respectfully Submitted to the Court -
