Clayton has been duly executed. So say cometh with the said Unity A. Clayton by her attorney as the said infants by R. G. Stiles appointed their guardian ad litem at the last Court. And therupon James Clayton his several deposits and debts as follows. that the said James E. Clayton made the following verbal will at his own house and in his last illness in presence of himself and others directed first that all his debts should be first paid, and that his wife Unity A. Clayton should keep all his property together for the benefit of herself and his children during life or widowhood but that on her death the property should go to his children and in event of marriage she should receive one third of his estate and the balance to his wife and in presence of himself and others called on bystanders to take notice thereto his will. And on motion is confirmed till after next Court.
