The Register of Colored free negroes was examined and certified to be truly made—

Found a negro man slave who has been committed to the Jail of this County for being permitted to go at large in the public nuisance and without the means of support himself by Joseph Brown his master. This day came as well the Attorney for the Commonwealth as the said Slave by his attorney who being fully heard it is ordered that the proceedings be quashed—

On the motion of James G. Monaghan it is ordered that as the administrator of Parker leave he out of any moneys in his hands belonging to Martha Ann, Andrew J. Roberts M. Robert M. and Benjamin F. Brown expend fifty dollars of each of the said infants estates for their board for the last year— and that he be authorized to expend forty dollars of the principal of each of the said infants estates exclusive of the income for their board for the present year—

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term—
