Ordered that the estate of Marshall Kelle dec. be committed to the hands of Stephen D. Kelle for administration according to law.

On the motion of the Oath of the firm against Lawrence & Ross. This day came the parties by their attorneys and the cause is continued till the next Term.

On the motion of Philip J. Glend. Ordered that one of the Comptrollers of this Court do state settle and adjust an account of said Glend's Comptrolship of Patricia Ross and make report thereof to Court.

The Registers of Deeds Warren, Robert Adams and Robert Adams for papers were examined and certified to be truly made.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
