

Superior dignity of which he may have notice before the expiration of some months from the date of the defendant's qualification as executor, and after paying all judgments due from himself against the defendant for debts of equal dignity, and after satisfying any debt due from the defendant to the defendant of equal dignity and paying likewise any debt for which the defendant is jointly liable with another that is so evidenced as to be of equal dignity. And the plaintiff further agrees that this judgment is not to operate as any admission or evidence of facts on the behalf of the defendant.

A Certificate of the qualification of John H. Bailey Commissioner of the Revenue was this day returned and ordered to be filed.

A Deed of Gift from Charles Davis to Amos Davis of the same was admitted and with the certificate of the same was ordered to be recorded.

An account current of Jonathan Darius administrator on the estate of Elizabeth Smith dec^d was returned and ordered to lie on the table for exceptions.

For reasons appearing to the Court It is ordered that the Indentures by which Susan Graham or Drake was bound to James W. Blount be transferred to Maria Blount widow of said James W. Blount according to law.

On the motion of Amos D. Moore. Ordered that G. W. McPherson be appointed Special Commissioner to take, settle and adjust an account of said Moore's administration on the estate of James C. Moore and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Emma D. Wells. Ordered that William D. Bond who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose to take, settle and adjust an account of said Wells' administration on the estate of Francis P. Wells dec^d and make report thereof to Court.

This cause was this day docketed by consent of parties with the report of the Court and came on to be heard on the bill and answer and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Samuel Lowmy, Joseph Bond, William C. Jones, and William D. Westbrook or any three of them who are hereby appointed Special Commissioners for the purpose to divide the negro slaves which Sarah Myrick held as her thirds of the estate of James Myrick dec^d into four equal portions do not let one to James W. Rivers as administrator of his wife's Estate one to Elizabeth Myrick and the remaining half to Howell Davis as guardians for said Myrick and Susan Myrick, but if a division in kind cannot be effected of said slaves, it shall be the duty of the Commissioners to sell as many as may be necessary to effect such purpose, and how they shall live, which as the premises make report to Court on or before a fourth day.

On the motion of Nathaniel P. Phillips guardian of Virginia Richards. Ordered that he be allowed to report out of the form of his said wards estate, the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars for her education, board &c.
