The Commissioner in this cause this day made this report which is in these words to wit: "A general survey of the County Court of Southampton dated November 17th 1843 which undersigned Commissioners have laid off and adjusted to Mr Martha T Everett one hundred and fifty nine acres of land more or less, as her lands in the lands of her late husband Everett do, whose whole tract of land contains four hundred and ninety one half acre more or less - which said lands land is bounded by the lands of Alex Myrick by his wife T Daniels and William Dayot etc and by a new line beginning in the road near the Dayots corner thence along the road N 35 W 44 1/2 poles thence N 55 E 58 poles to a post-morner lot thence N 22 1/2 W 54 poles to the lane thence along the lane N 55 1/2 E 50 poles to a corner Thence a new corner in Davis Thorpe line formerly William Dayots line etc also adjusted to the said Martha T Everett the following named negroes as her slaves in the slaves of her said late husband to wit David valued at two hundred and seventy five dollars per annum at five hundred and fifty dollars - Respectfully Submitted Alex Myrick Esq & Howell".

On the motion of Edward P Turner who made oath and together with William A Frost and Clark T Peale his securities entered into and acknowledged above in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Edward P Turner deceased in due form.

The last Will and Testament of Joseph C Bracken deceased was proved by the wife William P Moore and Goodman E Johnson his executors and administrators and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of William E Gay the record of whom was so made oath and together with Garrison D Moore Goodman E Johnson and J D Allen his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the will in due form.

On the motion of Richard M Carr who made oath and together with William P Moore and Philip J Claude his securities entered into and acknowledged above in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for the administration on the estate of Dolores Carr deceased in due form.

The Court doth forgive Richard M Carr guardian to Mary Carr nephew of Patience Carr and therefore he together with Philip J Claude and William P Moore his trustees Esq and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the
