The Comm'rs present on this cause this day made their report which is in these words to wit: 'Accordingly to a decree of the County Court of Southampton dated November Term 1823 which undersigned Comm'rs have laid off and assigned to Mrs Martha T. Everett one hundred and fifty more acres of land more or less, as her dower in the lands of her late husband late Everett do? whose whole tract of land contains four hundred and seventy one ^{half} more or less - which said dower land is bounded by the lands of Messrs. Hyatt of Longmans T. Everett and William Daymond &c and by a new line beginning in the east corner of Daymond corner, thence along the road N 55° W 4 1/2 paces, thence at 55° to 50 paces to a person more land, thence at 33 paces N 50° to the lane, thence along the lane at 50° to 50 paces to a corner of the new corner on Lewis Thomas line, formerly William Daymond's land, also assigned to the said Martha T. Everett the following amount, negroes as her dower in the slaves of her late husband to wit: David which is two hundred and seventy four ^{and fifty} lbs. Moore, Goodman E. Johnson and S. D. Moore has themselves entered into and acknowledged abroad in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

On the petition of Reuben M. Carr who made oath and together with William C. Gay and Philip J. Cloud has themselves entered into and acknowledged abroad in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Rebecca Carr deceased in due form.

The Court doth assign Richard M. Carr guardian to Mary Carr widow of Rebecca Carr and therefore he together with Philip J. Cloud and William D. Pope has themselves entered into and acknowledged abroad in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Rebecca Carr deceased in due form.
