On the motion of Donald Morris who made oath and together with William A Jones did
 so swear he having been called into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand
 dollars conditioned as the law directs certificated as granted him for drawing letters of
 administration on the estate of Thomas Falls deceased or see form.

Ordered that William A Jones, Dr W Edwards and John A Person being first duly
 sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose do affix their hands to this
 Thomas Falls deceased and return the appearance under their hands to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
