The Commission in this case this day made their report which is in these words to wit -
 Branch vs Branch. Report of Commission - In pursuance of the decree and undecided decree the
 Commission procured on the 17th day of December 1847 to sell the land on the premises and to have
 been disposed of the proceeds as directed. The Commission believing it would be to the interest of those
 entitled to the proceeds of said land to hold the land on a credit of twelve months instead of two months as
 was directed by the decree. The purchaser proposing to pay the cash instead of carrying his bonds
 payable twelve months after date, the Commission received it taking off the decreed and paid it over
 to the parties to whom the bonds were directed to be paid with the receipt of the amount paid. William
 B. Moore which has since been paid him as directed by the undecided decree. William Wells became
 the purchaser of the land on a credit of twelve months at the rate
