"I agree to be a devisor of the County Court of Southampton dated December 1847
Thomas B. Worrell Commissioner appointed by said Court in conjunction with Jacob Barnes
Commissioner acting under another decree of the Court sold the Court land and negroes of
Mrs. Mary Barrett on the 20th day of January 1848 and in my report to the Court I
stated that six of the said negroes had absconded. And in my second report I stated that
four of them had been retaken and returned by the purchaser, Walter Myrick. On the 10th day
of February last, 1849, another of said absconded negroes named Bright was returned by the
purchaser Walter Myrick, of the Parish of St. James County, at the price for which he let
him off at at the sale land
