At a meeting of the County Court of Southampton dated December last 1847, James B. Worrell Commissioner appointed by said court in conjunction with said Court Commissioner acting under another decree of the Court sold the several land and negroes of Mrs. Mary Barrell on the 20th day of January 1848, and in my report to the Court I stated that two of the said negroes had absconded. And in my second report I stated the four of them had been collected and received by the purchaser, Walter Myrick. On the 21st of February last 1849, another of said absconded negroes named Wright was received by the purchaser, Walter Myrick, of the State of Brunswick County, at the price for which he had him off at the sale last.
