Appeal

Upon an appeal from
the judgment of a Justice

recovered by the appellee against the appellant the 15th January 1849 for \$20 with interest from
the 9th October 1848 till paid and costs.

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This day came the parties by their attorneys, who being fully heard and the evidence adduced duly considered
it seems to the Court that there is no error in the judgment aforesaid. Therefore it is considered that the same
be affirmed, and that the appellee receive against the appellant and Mills D. Finner his bounty on the
appeal, the amount thereof, together with ten per centum per annum damages thereon from the aforesaid
15th of January 1849 till payment and his costs by him about his defence on this behalf expended.

Ordered that Jovin Gifford, Richard A. Smith, and William R. Stephenson being first duly sworn
before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of William Seguer
deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of James D. McPherson Curator of Elizabeth & Ellen Stearns Ordered that he be
allowed to capture forty dollars of the principal of each of the aforesaid estates for their support &c.

Ordered that John J. Davis who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose do state settle and adjust an account of John D. McKee's administration on the estate of Joseph Archibald dec'd
and make report thereof to the Court.

The Registers of Isaac Chappell and Peggy Powell for oaths were examined & satisfied to be
truly made.

On the motion of William J. Schell Ordered that Lilliston R. Edwards who is hereby appointed
Special Commissioner for the purpose do state settle and adjust an account of said Schell's admin-
istration on the estate of Daniel H. Dringdale dec'd and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
