the 9<sup>th</sup> October 1848 bill paid and costs  
recovered by the appellee against the appellant the 15<sup>th</sup> January 1849 for \$20 with interest from

Will they come the parties by their attorneys, who being fully heard and the evidence adduced minutely considered  
it seems to the Court that there is no error in the judgment aforesaid. Therefore it is ordered that the Court  
be affirmed, and that the appellee receive against the appellant and Mills D. Ingers his bounty on the  
appeal, the amount thereof, together with ten per centum per annum damages thereon from the aforesaid  
15<sup>th</sup> of January 1849 till payment and his cost by him about his defence on this behalf expended.

Ordered that Jervis Griffin, Richard A. Smith, and William R. Stephenson being first duly sworn  
before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of William Ingers so  
deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of James D. Haysbury executor of Elizabeth & Ellen Ingers Ordered that he be  
allowed to receive forty dollars of the principal of each of the aforesaid estates for their support &c

Ordered that John S. Davis who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose do state  
bills and adjust an account of John D. Clarke's administration on the estate of Joseph Nicholas dec'd  
and make report thereof to the Court.

The Registrars of Susan Chappell and Peggy Powell for negroes were examined & satisfied to be  
truly made.

On the motion of William J. Thell Ordered that Lullaton R. Edwards who is hereby appointed  
Special Commissioner for the purpose do state bills and adjust an account of his Thell's adminis-  
tration on the estate of Daniel H. Dringdale dec'd and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term
