

The Account of Eliza V. Davis' Guardianship of Edgar W. and Clinton L. Davis, of Wm J. Gray's Guardianship of Benjamin F. Richard, and Nancy Gray and Virginia Johnson - having been brought up and upwards in the Clerk's Office, and no exceptions being filed thereto they were severally examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

The Account of Samuel Wells Sheriff and Administrator of Benj L. Barnes together with an account of debts and demands against the said Barnes or his Estate, and an account appertaining the funds in the hands of the said Wells to be administered, having been brought up and upwards for exceptions and no exceptions being filed the account current is hereby confirmed; And upon the petition of Lucy L. Barnes, whose claim against the said Barnes' Estate was not presented to the Commissioners, White, and was therefore not included in his Report of Debt and Report of Appointments, the Court being satisfied that the claim of the said Lucy L. Barnes for (\$23.60) Twenty three dollars and sixty cents, with interest thereon from January 1st 1848 is just. The Court doth adjudge, order and decree, that Samuel Wells Sheriff and administrator of Benj L. Barnes, pay out of his own Estate, within the debts proved before the said Commissioners White including the said debt due to Lucy L. Barnes the sum of (thirteen hundred and seventy four dollars and fifty seven cents, with the interest due thereon, first paying John J. Kendrick, Attorney, a fee of Five dollars for professional services.

The Account of Samuel Wells' administration on the Estate of Obediah Vick died. The account of debts and demands against the said Obediah Vick or his Estate, and the account appertaining the amount in the hands of the administrator amongst the creditors, having been brought up and upwards in the Clerk's Office and no exceptions being filed, they were examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded - and the Court doth order and decree, that Samuel Wells, administrator as aforesaid, pay to Davis Vick \$11.14 to Wm. Hamel \$4.10 to Sally Vick \$4.42 to J. A. Rochelle \$11.50 to James J. Tardus \$1.70 to Wm. St. Lawrence \$3.70 to Elyabiah Phillips \$8.84 to S. St. Bishop \$1.54 and to St. P. Pope \$2.40 - with interest on above respective amounts from & towards 23rd 1847, till paid.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
