

and decrees, that a Commissioner of this Court enquire into and report to this Court, what amount John W. Rockwell and John Taylor & Co. and Martha his wife, have received from James Rockwell's Estate or accounts of their half brother Henry Gray. But the said Wm. B. Shant shall not proceed to act under this decree until he shall have executed a Bond in the penalty of Two Thousand Dollars, in the Clerk's office of this Court, with Sufficient Security for the faithful performance of this decree, and any return, which may be entered in this Cause.

And the Motion of Edward E. Hedley, who reads Oath according to law, and together with J. C. Howell his Security, who it was proved to the Satisfaction of the Court was Sufficiently entered into an acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of One Thousand dollars, Conditioned according to law, which Bond is ordered to be recorded - Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Wm. J. Hedley and in due form.

The Court doth appoint John Pope Guardian of Sarah J. Adeline and Malissa A. Pope, Orphans of Elisha Pope and and thereupon he together with Amos S. Pope his Security, entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Seven hundred dollars, Conditioned according to law - which Bond is ordered to be recorded.

A Paper writing bearing date the 20th day of Oct 1844, purporting to be the last will and Testament of Joseph St. James, was presented to the Court for probate - and being proved to the Court that the said Joseph St. James, intermarried since the execution of the said will, which revoked the said will, the Court therefore refused to admit the said writing to record, as the last will and Testament of the said Joseph St. James did.

And the Motion of Wm. S. Goddard, who reads Oath according to law, and together with F. S. Ridley his Security, (also justified on Oath as to his Sufficiency,) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Seven Thousand Dollars, Conditioned according to law, which Bond is ordered to be recorded - Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of the said Joseph St. James and in due form.
