Steven Ford who stands bound by his recognizance entered into before E. B. Beaton a Justice of the Peace for this County for his appearance before this Court on the first day of September Term last having failed to appear On the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth it is ordered that a writ of *habeas corpus* be issued against the said Steven Ford & Peter Everett, Wm. G. Williams & Randall Edwards. & Anthony Arbel his securities in said recognizance returnable here on the first day of the next quarterly Term of this Court to show cause if any they can why the Commonwealth of Virginia, execution against them the said Steven Ford & his said securities for the several sums of money set forth in their said recognizance, ought not to have if so considered by said Court. And further to do and receive what our said Court may in that behalf consider.

The Commissioners appointed to act in conjunction with Commissioners appointed by the Court of Hanover County in letting to the lowest bidder the keeping of the Ferry at New South Quay this day returned their report with a bond taken from the undertaker. And the Court approving the proceedings of the Commissioners ratifies the same.

Ordered that James Wells late Sheriff of this County, out of any contingent money in his hands yet received appropriated, pay to William B. Edwards the sum thirty six dollars and twenty five cents the amount of his account for Records furnished to this Court.

Ordered that the Court do adjourn till tomorrow morning ten o'clock.
