The Judge of this Court being so situated as to render it improper in
his Judgment for him to preside in the trial of this Cause, it is
ordered that the same be removed to the Circuit Court of Southampton
County

John Ricketts or Freeman who stands Indicted of Larceny this day appeared in
Court in discharge of his recognizance, and was set to the bar in
Court by the Sheriff of this County. Being thereof arraigned pleaded
not guilty to the Indictment, and a panel of twenty four freeholders
summoned by the Sheriff, were examined by the Court, found free from
all legal exceptions, and qualified to serve as Jurors according to
law. Thereupon the accused was called to the panel eight of said jurors
and from the remaining sixteen the following twelve jurors were select-
ed by lot, to whom there was no objection, to wit; Jas S. Bishop,
James Britton, Collins A. Ricketts, J. J. Watkins, John Ellis, Adolphus
Johnson, Richard Leigh, Wm Brantley, Carr Beale, J. St. Kinard,
James Langhorne & J. I. St. Barham, who were sworn the truth of
what upon the premises to speak; and after hearing the evidence and
arguments of Counsel, returned to their room to consult on a verdict,
and after some time returned into Court, having found the following
Verdict, to wit; "We the Jury find the Defendant not Guilty", Thereupon
proclamation being made as the manner is and nothing further
appearing or being alleged against the said John Ricketts or Free-
man, It is considered by the Court that he be acquitted of
the Larceny aforesaid and be discharged from custody.

Isaac Artis who stands Indicted of Larceny, this day appeared
in Court in discharge of his recognizance and was set
to the bar in Court by the Sheriff of this County,
and the Attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth, with
the consent of the Court, says that he will not
further prosecute against the said Isaac Artis upon

he be discharged from custody.
