Nicholas and Supman Daughan, who were sworn the trust to speak of and upon the passing and after hearing the evidence and arguments of Counsel, returned to their room to consult on a Verdict, and after some time, returned into Court, having found the following Verdict to wit; "We the Jury find the prisoner not guilty," wherefore proclamation being made as the Warrant is and nothing further appearing or being alleged against the said Jeremiah Copeland. It is considered by the Court that he be acquitted and discharged of the offence aforesaid.
