It appearing to the Court that immediately after the Commencement of the Lunatic and it being once in every two months thereafter application was made to the board of directors of the Asylums for admission, and that such application was refused for want of room.

Ordered that the account of Mrs. Henry S. Howard Jailor of this County, amounting to Sixteen dollars & seventy five cents, be certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination & payment.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the 27th of July 1870.
