

The Court appoints James L. Bishop, Commissioner of Roads in the Township of Newcomb Sept., in this County for the term of one year commencing on the first day of July 1840 to fill the vacancy caused by the failure of John I. Luter to qualify, and thereupon the said James L. Bishop took and subscribed the Oaths required by law.

On the Motion of Lewis E. Adams, who made Oath as the law directs, and entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two Thousand dollars, Conditioned according to law, with Lewis E. Adams and Wm. W. Cobb his Sureties, (who justified in Cash as to their Sufficiency,) and which said bond being acknowledged by the obligors therein, is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Mary A. Adams deceased in due form. It being shown that the Estate of effects for and in respect to which such letters of administration applied for does not exceed the value of \$1000.

On the Motion of Robert Rowland, who made Oath as the law directs, and entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four hundred dollars, Conditioned according to law, with James E. Peters, his Surety, (who justified in Cash as to his Sufficiency,) and which said bond being acknowledged by the obligors therein is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Sarah Harwood deceased in due form.

Wm. W. Briggs Sheriff of this County with Consent of the Court doth appoint R. P. Loper, his Deputy, and thereupon the said R. P. Loper took and subscribed the Oaths required by law. It appearing to the Court that the said R. P. Loper is a man of honesty & good demeanor.

James Kello, late Sheriff of this County with Consent of the Court, doth appoint Charles Beale his Deputy, and thereupon the said Charles Beale took and subscribed the Oaths required by law. It appearing to the Court that the said Charles Beale is a man of honesty and good demeanor.

Ordered that on the Motion of James Edwards It is ordered that Notice be issued to Margaret S. Barnett, that at the next Term of this Court ^{Motion} will be made to appoint a Trustee in and out of Trust lately admitted to record in this Court and executed by her as grantor, in place of Geo. St. J. and also if refused to act.
