Ordered that the account of Mrs. St. L. Steward, Jailor of this County, amounting to \$33.75 for the board of Samuel Briggs ^{and} Lunatic, be Certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination & payment.

Ordered that the account of Mrs. St. L. Steward, Jailor of this County, amounting to \$20.50, be Certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination & payment. It appearing to the Court that immediately after the Commitment of the Lunatic & it had been in writing two weeks thereafter, application was made to the Board of Directors of both Asylums for admission, and that such application was refused for want of room.

The Court appoints Richard S. Bayliss, Justice of the Peace in the Township of Berlin & Iron, for the term of one year commencing on the 1st day of July 1870, to fill the vacancy caused by the said R. S. Bayliss's failure to qualify. The said Bayliss took and Subscribed the Oath required by law.

On the Motion of R. W. Arnold who made Oath of the law duly, and entered into a bond in the penalty of \$2000 - Conditions according to law - with John Arnold his Security, (who justified on Oath as his Sufficiency) and who waives the benefit of his legal exemption from said obligation - by the obligors thereto, and having a Stamp of the Sub. Sec. of the U.S. to the amount of two dollars affixed thereto and duly Cancelled is ordered to be recorded - Certificate is granted the said R. W. Arnold for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Isaac M. Arnold decd - in due form. It being sworn that the estate & effects for and in respect to which such letters of administration applied for exceed the value of \$1000 - but does not exceed the value of \$2000.00 - Stamps of the Sub. Sec. of the U.S. to the value of \$1.00 - being affixed thereto and duly Cancelled.



Ordered that William W. Briggs, W. W. Little, James E. Seabell and William A. Seabell, being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels of the estate of Isaac M. Arnold decd - and return the appraisement under their hands to the clerk of this court.
