This day this cause was docketed by consent of parties and leave
of the Court, and the complainants filed their bill and in their
petition L. R. Edwards is assigned Guardian ad litem to the Infant
Defendants John P. Bland and Elizabeth the said Guardian ad
litem filed the answer of the said Infant, and the said
J. St. Thomas filed his answer, to which answers the plaintiff
replied generally, and the cause coming on to be heard, by
the like leave and consent, upon the bill, the said answer
general replication thereto, was argued by counsel; and the
Court after consideration of the bill docketed, order and decree
that partition be made of the several parcels of land of
which Philip Bland died seized, and for the purpose of
effecting such partition, the Court doth order that
Charles Knight, James Pope, A. B. Barnett, Lewis Marks,
and Mills R. Gray, any three of whom may act,
who are hereby appointed Commissioners for that purpose,
do proceed to lay off and divide the said real Estate into
three equal parts, having regard to quality and quantity
and assign one of said three parts to J. St. Thomas for
his life, one third part to R. S. Pope and Mary E. his
wife, and one third part to John P. Bland.
And the said Commissioners are required to report their
proceedings under this order to Court, in order to a
final decree.
