Harris as Commissioner, after having given twenty days notice of the time, place & terms of sale, upon the following terms, one half cash, the balance on credit of twelve months, the purchaser to execute Bond with satisfactory security, interest from day of sale and the title to be retained until the further order of this Court, or in the discretion of the purchaser the whole of the purchase money may be paid in cash.
