

Lydia M. Buxton sixty dollars, and should the amount of sales
 be not enough to pay the above said parties in full, then
 pay them their legacies pro rata, but should there be a
 surplus after paying the said special legacies, then
 the said Commissioners will divide the same into eight
 equal shares, and allot one share to Joshua Pickens, one
 share to Allen Cotton and Elmina his wife, one share to
 James Buxton, one share to Lydia M. Buxton, one sixth of
 one eighth to William Barney, one sixth of one eighth to
 Samuel Barney, one sixth of one eighth to Francis Chas. Smith,
 one sixth of one eighth to Eliza Whitley, one sixth of one
 eighth to John Barney, one sixth of one eighth to
 Elizabeth Barney, one third of one eighth to Abby
 Gardner, one third of one eighth to Fannetta Gardner,
 one third of one eighth to Mary M. Gardner, one
 eighth to Euphany Gardner, and one eighth to Temperance
 Tyler and Mildred his wife, and the said Commissioners
 is hereby directed to report his proceedings to this
 Court in order to a further decree. But the said
 Commissioners shall not proceed to act under this
 Decree, until he shall have given a Bond in the
 penalty of Five hundred dollars, with good security,
 conditioned for a faithful performance of this and
 any other decree which may be entered in this Cause.

Robert Hedgespeth, who stands convicted of grand larceny,
 was again led to the bar in custody of the Jailor of this
 County, and it being demanded of him, if anything for him-
 self he had, or knew to say, why the Court should not
 now proceed to pronounce judgment against him according
 to law, and nothing being offered or alleged in defence of
 judgment, it is considered by the Court that the said Robert
 Hedgespeth, be imprisoned in the Penitentiary of this
 Commonwealth for the term of five years, the period of
 the Surors in their verdict ascertained, and the Sheriff
 of this County is ordered as soon as possible after the adjourn-
 ment of this Court, to remove and convey the said Robert
 Hedgespeth, to the Penitentiary of this Commonwealth
 therein to be kept imprisoned, and treated in the manner
 directed by Law, and the Prisoner is remanded to Jailor.
