This cause was this day again heard on the papers read and the report of Commissioner Sebell made pursuant to the decree of November Term last, to which there being no exception the same is confirmed. And the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that M. W. Briggs Sheriff of this County sell, at auction, after having duly advertised the same, all of the real estate of which Robert S. Barnes died seized and possessed and mentioned in the said Commissioner Sebell's report. On the following Terms to wit: Sufficient in cash to pay the expenses of sale and the costs of this suit including \$25.00 attorney's fee and the residue on a credit of three years, taking bond with sufficient personal security from the purchaser for the deferred payment and retaining the title till the whole purchase money is paid, and report to Court returning said bond. And it is further ordered that one of the Commissioners of this Court take and report a further account of the debts against the said Robert S. Barnes or his estate.

On the motion of Richard Holcomb and for reasons appearing to the Court this exemption from the payment of taxes in future on account of age and infirmity -

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
