This day this Cause came on to be heard by Counsel of parties on the bill of the Complainants and L. R. Edwards her next friend and answer of the Defendant infant by R. R. Griffin her Guardian ad litem, general replication thereto, and was argued by Counsel; on consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, Order and decree that R. R. Griffin be appointed Commissioner to sell by private sale, or public auction, the land here more advantageous to the Estate, if by auction, not until duly advertised before the Court house door and various other public places in the County, to be sold on the premises on a Credit of six months months such as may be required in cash to pay costs of suit and expenses of sale and to pay such bills for fees and as may be.
