



The oath of Mills Eley subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of James M Corbitt the Executor named in the said Will who made oath and entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned according to law but without security the will requesting that no security should be required of him and the court requiring none - Certificate is granted the said James M Corbitt for obtaining letters of administration of the said Will in due form

Ordered that Junius R Person, Wm Harris, Carr Holland & B. B Jacy or any three of them being first duly sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of John Whitehead dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands according to law

The last Will and Testament of James R Joyner dec^d was proved by the oaths of Geo R Branch & Benj W Goodwyn the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and Ben E Pope the executor therein named refusing to take upon himself the burthen of the execution thereof and no person applying for administration on this estate and the said James R Joyner having been dead more than three months it is ordered that Wm W Briggs Sheriff of this County take the estate of the said James R Joyner into his hands and administer the same according to law

Ordered that George E Beaton, Geo R Branch & B F Harrison being first duly sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of James R Joyner dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands according to law

The Court doth assign Joseph B Prince guardian of Benj^r Mary, Clara, George & Martha Ellis orphans of Benjamin Ellis dec^d and thereupon the said Joseph B Prince together with Joseph H Prince his security, who justified on oath as to his sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Eight hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs

The Court doth assign Joseph B Prince guardian of Richard Ellis & Thomas Ellis orphans of Samuel Ellis dec^d and thereupon the said Joseph B Prince with Joseph H Prince his security, who justified on oath as to his sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs

Ordered that Charles W Nicholson administrator of Jordan T Whitehead dec^d pay to Jacob Williams, out of the estate of his intestate in his hands to be administered One hundred fifty dollars for the board of the three infant children of the said Jordan T Whitehead for the year 1870
