Gray, Guardian of Richard Gray the Court doth order that he be allowed to expend the sum of Seventy five dollars, out of the principal of his ward's Estate, for the year 1871, for his board and clothes and the sum of Twenty dollars, out of the principal of his ward Virginia's Estate, for her maintenance and support for the year 1871.
