This day the plaintiffs filed their bill praying an injunction enjoining Wm W Briggs Sheriff of Southampton from proceeding to execute the decree of this Court rendered on the 28 day of February 1871 in a suit in Chancery therein pending between Rob and the injunction asked for in this case by the plaintiffs is refused, but the plaintiffs stating that they think themselves aggrieved by the above order or refusal and that they desire an appeal therefrom to the Circuit Court of this County and intend to apply for an appeal therefrom pursuant to the provisions of the act passed the 23^d of June 1870, the Court doth allow sixty days as the time within which the said plaintiffs may apply for such appeal and doth order that the execution of the decree of the February Term 1871 in the case of Dole v. Joyner be suspended for that time provided the said Charles M Joyner & Wm H Jenkins or some responsible person shall enter into bond with sufficient security in the penalty of one thousand dollars with a condition according to law

Ordered that the account of Joseph B Prince attorney for the Commonwealth in this Court amounting to twenty dollars be certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination and payment.
