Blow, L. L. Manry, D. H. Kindred, Walter Ford & J. D. A. Barham who being elected tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue joined upon their oaths day. We the jury find for the plaintiff and assess the damages at Ninety two dollars & forty seven cents with interest thereon from 1st day September 1866. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant Five hundred dollars the debt in the declaration mentioned and their costs by them about their suit in this behalf expended.

But this judgment is to be discharged by the payment of Ninety two dollars & forty seven cents the damages assessed as aforesaid with interest thereon from the 1st day of September 1866 till paid and the costs.
