Fribble It is ordered that the Order granted to the late Robert Fribble (at the March term of this Court 1861) for opening a Road from San Jeff to Little Swamp Bridge, to be amended as to read as follows; to wit, Said Road to Commence at San Jeff on the Norfolk & Petersburg Rail Road and terminate on the Proctor's Bridge road, at a point as near as practicable to Proctor's Bridge. The Road between San and said Bridge to be made as straight as the circumstances will admit of and this Order revokes the Order made at the last term of this Court, in reference to the above named road And the Commissioners are ordered to Report their proceedings to Court for Confirmation or rejection.

On Motion, It is ordered that Joseph Swallow, Peter Hobbes and Benjamin Drow, proceed within a reasonable time after Notice of this Order to view in conjunction with like Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Isle of Wight County at the March Term thereof and make report to this Court the Conditions and manner in which Proctor's Bridge should be rebuilt. And it is further ordered that the County Court of Isle of Wight County be apprised of this Court's action in the premises.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
