Lord & Co. Salvo, Clarke & Co. Ferret, Beal & Co. Byrd, Dorman &
John W. Jenkins, Winsfield and Co. and Bancroft, Bache & Co.,
who are out of this Commonwealth, in the regard
prescribed by law against absent Defendants and they
still failing to appear and make defense, came on
this day to be heard on the Bill taken for Complaint
as to the Defendants John J. Kindred, Trustee, and J. L.
Tate, Sheriff, in whom process had been duly executed, and
they still failing to appear and make defense; and on exhibits
filed with said Bill, and on the Report of W. W. Briggs, Receiver
this day filed, and on the answer of said James W. Tates,
and replication thereto, and no answer of said Bill, this
day filed and joined thereto, and was argued by Counsel;
on consideration whereof the Court doth approve said answer,
and doth confirm said Report of Receiver Briggs, (the which there
is no exception,) and doth decide that the appts in the
hands of said Briggs, Receiver as aforesaid, and subject to the
provisions of the Act of Trust executed by said James W. Tates
to John J. Kindred, Trustee, and dated the 18th of July 1870,
and filed as an exhibit in the Cause; and doth adjudge,
order and decree, That the Commissioner of this Court State
and settle the accounts of said W. W. Briggs, Receiver as
aforesaid, and ascertain and Report the priorities of the several
parties secured by said Act of Trust and the amounts due
each, and make report with any matters specially stated,
deemed pertinent by himself, and what any of the parties
may require to be so stated.
