

John C. Kindred the Commissioner of accounts being disqualified from acting as such by reason of interest in the settlement of William G. Goodwyns transactions as Executor of Samuel Drewry dec^d and of his administration on the estate of Joseph A. Drewry dec^d. It is ordered that John N. Sebrill one of the Commissioners in Chancery in this Court do act in the place of the said Kindred in the settlement of said accounts.

On the motion of Thomas Harcum and Silas Murfee et al^s. It is ordered that they be exempt from the payment of taxes and levies in future on account of age and infirmity.

Ordered that E. C. Barritt, Davis Barritt & Parker & Story do let to the lowest undertaker the rebuilding the Embankment and bridges connected therewith on the West side of the Nottoway River at the Cypress bridge receive the same when completed according to contract and make report to Court.

The Commissioners appointed by this Court at its ^{March} term to act in conjunction with the Commissioners appointed by the Court of Isle of Wight County, to view and report the manner and condition in which Broctons Bridge across Black Water River should be rebuilt, this day returned their report. On consideration whereof it is ordered that Joseph J. Gwaltney, Peter J. Holmes & Benj. C. Drew or any two of them, proceed in conjunction with like Commissioners from the County of Isle of Wight do let out the rebuilding of said bridge to the lowest undertaker, after due notice thereof, and make report to this Court. And it is further ordered that a copy of this order be certified to the County Court of Isle of Wight County.

Taylor Worrell who stands indicted for stealing bank notes was this day set to the bar in custody of the jailor of this Court and the said Taylor Worrell being a minor under the age of twenty one years Samuel Worrell his father with Robert M. Barnes his security here in Court acknowledged themselves indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia as follows. The said Samuel Worrell in the sum of fifty dollars and the said Robert M. Barnes his security in the like sum of fifty dollars to be levied of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements for the use of the said Commonwealth; but to be void if the said Taylor Worrell shall personally appear in this Court on the first day of the next quarterly term surrender himself into custody and not depart thence without leave of the Court.

The Commissioners appointed at the last term of this Court to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Moores Bridge across the three creeks near Drewryville this day made a report. Whereupon the Court approving the same doth order that the said Commissioners Jas. E. Peters, John Williams & A. G. Ryland take bond with good security of John R. Nicholson the undertaker conditioned for the faithful performance of the contract, receive said bridge when completed according to contract and make report to Court.
