 her ordinary at Franklin, S. St. Marshall and Joseph Chappell at
 their ordinaries at Iron Depot, Mrs. Howard and E. J. Gardner at
 their ordinaries in Jerusalem, and said J. J. Dardner and Co, C. C.
 Williams and C. W. Nicholson, at their respective stores in
 this county; The Court being satisfied that places where the same
 is to be sold are suitable and that the applicants are persons of
 sobriety and good Character.

On the application of Joseph Mop to keep an ordinary at his
 house in Franklin, after hearing the applicant and all the evidence
 adduced, the said application is refused.

On the motion of Mary Ann Gibson. It is ordered that James
 Munroe Cutler be summoned to appear to the first day of
 May Term next to show cause (if any he can,) why he detains
 a Negro Boy, Esbridge Child of said Mary Ann Gibson, and
 why he should not surrender the said child to its mother.
 And it is further ordered that the said Cutler produce
 before the Court the body of the said Boy Esbridge; and it
 is ordered that the said Cutler be served with a copy
 of this order.

On the application of William M. Schrew to retail
 liquors at his store in this County, the Court being
 satisfied that the place where the same is to be sold is
 suitable and that the applicant is a person of sobriety and
 good Character.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow
 morning ten O'clock.
