

That the Commissioners of said Court take and settle the following accounts, to wit; 1st An account of the transactions of said Richmond T. Sillars as late Guardian of the female pauper named Victoria, late Victoria Bryant, taking the accounts returned by said Richmond T. Sillars, Guardian as aforesaid, to Southampton County Court, as prima facie correct, subject to be surcharged and falsified and report to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or that any of the parties may require to be so stated.

Simeon Wells who stands indicted for Murder was this day set to the bar in custody of the Jailor of this Court, whereupon on motion of the said Simeon Wells, and for reasons appearing to the Court, his trial is postponed till the first day of the next term of this Court and whereupon the said Simeon Wells is remanded to jail.

John C. Griffin, Geo. W. Sperry and Jeph Boykin, here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of two hundred dollars, each, to be paid of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements, for the use of said Commonwealth but to be void if said John C. Griffin, Geo. W. Sperry and Jeph Boykin, shall personally appear in this Court on the first day of the next term to testify in behalf of the Commonwealth against Simeon Wells who stands indicted of Murder, and not depart thence without leave of the Court.

John Cherry and David Irons, here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia, in the sum of two hundred dollars, each, to be paid of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements, for the use of the said Commonwealth, but to be void if said John Cherry and David Irons shall personally appear in this Court on the first day of the next term to testify in behalf of Simeon Wells who stands indicted of Murder, and not depart thence without leave of the Court.

Richard S. Boykin who was summoned here this day as a witness in behalf of the Commonwealth against Simeon Wells indicted for Murder was solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is ordered that he be summoned here to the first day of the next term to show cause if any he can, why an attachment should not be issued against him for his said contempt.
