Morris and Virginia his wife (Legatee of James Wills dec'd) \$296.29; To Wm. P. Morris and Virginia his wife, (Legatee of James W. Wills dec'd) \$296.29; To Richard Everett and Estella his wife, \$296.29 and to Edwin Parker and Sarah his wife, \$296.29; and that the said Joley Sheriff and Committee of James Wills dec'd - render a further account of his transactions as such Representative on the estate of James Wills dec'd - which two of the Commissioners of this Court, will state and settle and Report to Court.

On the motion of Isham Day, ed., James E. Rollings ed., Jarrall Aris ed., Hardy Lamb ed., Ruffin Nichols & Willis Story and for reasons appearing to the Court they are severally exempt from the payment of taxes and levies in future, they being aged & infirm.

On the motion of C. C. Williams It is ordered that Wm. W. Briggs Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of Joseph H. Vick & administer the same according to law.

The Commissioners heretofore appointed to let the rebuilding of Smiths & Pettways Bridge this day made their report which is approved & confirmed by the Court.

Geo. W. Stephenson the Commissioner of Roads who was appointed to let the opening of a new road commencing at Ivor Depot on the Norfolk & Petersburg Rail Road and terminate at the Proctors bridge road at a point as near as practicable to Proctors bridge this day made his report which is continued till the next Term of this Court.

On the motion of Thomas B. Powell it is ordered that Thomas B. Powell P. S. Thomas & David Turner be and they are hereby appointed viewers for the purpose of viewing the path leading by Thomas B. Powell's, P. S. Thomas into the public road near Railways bridge and report to Court the conveniences or inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as to the public if such path shall be established as a public road and report specially whether any yard, garden, orchard or any part thereof will have to be taken.
