On the motion of Mary Ann Gibson against Jas. Monroe Butler the summons awarded at the last term not having been executed it is ordered that another summons be issued against the said Butler returnable to the first day of the next Term of this Court.

On the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth and for reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that the Venue Facias issued returnable here this day for the trial of Simon Wells indicted for murder be quashed and that another Venue Facias be issued to the Sheriff of this County to be directed to cause to appear here instant twenty four persons freeholders of this County residing remote from the place where the murder of which Simon Wells is accused is charged to have been committed and qualified in this respects to serve as jurors for the trial of the said Simon Wells.

The Commissioners appointed to let out the rebuilding of the bridges and embankment at the Cypress Bridge this day returned their report of which the Court approves. And it is ordered that the same Commissioners E. C. Barrett & Davis Barrett enter into a written contract and take bond & security of the undertaker conditioned for the faithful performance of the contract and return the same for the approval or rejection of the Court.
