

died also before his father, leaving three children, to wit, Samuel Hines, Coris Hines and John Hines, Minors; and Sylvanus Hines, one of the Executors named in the said Will.

This Cause was this day Doctored by leave of Court, and Consent of parties, and by the like leave, and Consent, Came on to be heard on the Complainant's Bill, the answer of Defendants and Exhibits filed, and replication thereto, and was argued by Counsel, on Consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, Order and decree, that Sylvanus Hines, Executor do being next of John Hines, do pay to Martha Hines, widow of the said deceased, the just and equal third of the net proceeds in his hands resulting from the sale of the personal estate of the said deceased after first paying, delivering and satisfying all the specific legacies and devises made in the last will and Testament of the said deceased; the said one third to be held in fee by the said Martha Hines, in lieu of her life Estate in the whole of the said personal Estate; and the said Executor is directed to report to this Court in Order to a final Decree.

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Ordered that Edward E. Hedley be summoned here on the first day of June Term next, to show Cause if any, he can why an Information should not be filed against him, upon the presentment made against him, by the Grand Jury on yesterday.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until the first day of the next Term.
