Gardner and wife to Richard E. Story to Margaret Story and
others, conveying real Estate, was admitted to record, May the
18th 1871.

Deed of James B. Lewis, dated 8th day of June 1871, selling
lands and personal property, Under an act
of the General Assembly of Virginia, was admitted to
record, June the 9th 1871.
