On the motion of Patrick Kane, G. W. Briggs, John Allen and Frank Jones et al
and for reasons appearing to the Court, they are severally exempt from the payment
of taxes and levies in future, they being aged and infirm.

Ordered that the account of Joseph B. Paine et al for the Commissioner's account
to thirty dollars, be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination
and payment.

It is ordered by the Court that the Sheriff of this County, out of the Contingent fund
in his hands, pay to Benj. E. Horne the sum of Two hundred and thirteen dollars
it being the amount agreed to be paid him for enclosing the Public Square.

It is ordered that Robert Ireland, James E. Peters and G. W. Briggs be and they
are hereby appointed Special Commissioners to sit to the Court under the
rebuilding of the Bridge across Westbrook's Mill Swamp in Southampton County,
and report to Court their proceedings under this order.

Ordered that the account of Pelage Caron, Constable, amounting to Eighteen
Dollars, be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts, for his examination and
payment.

Ordered that William B. Sanders, Joseph H. Barkman, J. J. Little, Geo. J. Turner,
and H. J. Barkman be and they are hereby appointed Special Commissioners
(any three of whom may act,) for the purpose of letting to the Court
under take the repairs of Cary's Bridge. And they are ordered to return
the Specifications together with their report to Court for ratification or rejection.

It is ordered by the Court that the Registers of this County furnish the
Judge of this County with a copy of their registration Books and that
a reasonable charge be allowed them to be paid by the Treasurer
of this County, out of the funds that may come into his hands.

On the Application of W. S. Bracy to retail liquor at his Store
in this County near Franklin Depot, the Court being satisfied that
the place where the same is to be sold, is suitable and that the
applicant is a person of Sobriety and good character.

Ordered that W. W. Briggs Sheriff of this County out of any
Contingent money in his hands, pay to James White Clerk of
this Court, the sum of Twenty Dollars, for Copying the Books
of the Commissioners of the Revenue for Apprais.

Ordered that the account of W. W. Briggs Sheriff of this County amounting to
fifteen dollars, be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his
examination and payment.
