Esau Briggs, who was elected a Justice of the Peace, in the Township of Ironyville in this County by the qualified Voters thereof, at the Election held on the 25. day of May 1871, for the term of three years, Commencing on the 1st day of July 1871, and after said term of Office shall have expired, until his Successor is qualified to enter upon the discharge of the duties of said Office, this day qualified, by taking and subscribing the Oaths required by law.
