And the Sheriff of this County is ordered, as soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court to remove and convey the said Robert Taylor from the jail of this Court to the Penitentiary of this Commonwealth, there to be kept imprisoned and treated in the manner directed by law for the term aforesaid, and the Prisoner is remanded to jail.
