This day this Cause came on to be again heard on the papers formerly read and the Rept of Commissioner Scales made in pursuance of an Order entered at the June Term 1871, of this Court, and was argued by Counsel, on Consideration whereof the Court Confirming said report to which we excepting have been filed, do hereby adjudge, Order and decree, that Martha Griggard pay to Samuel Rollings the sum of \$31.57 with interest thereon from January the 12th 1859 till paid, and the sum of \$1.90 as costs, and that the said Griggard pay to same Rollings admin^r of John Rawlings the sum of \$94.03 with interest on \$50. part thereof from December 20. 1866, and on \$44.03 the residue thereof from Jan^y 1st 1861, till paid, and also the sum of \$1.90 costs.

But liberty is reserved to the Plff should this Term prove unavailing to proceed against any of the other parties defendant to this Cause. And the Court do hereby further Order and decree, that a Commissioner of this Court take an account of the annual value of the dower interest of the said Martha Griggard in the real estate of William Griggard decd, and a Commissioner of this Court is further ordered to audit and settle an account of the Administration of Susan M. Harris in the Estate of H. S. Harris, and report the same to Court, together with any matters specially stated, deemed pertinent by himself, or which may be required to be so stated by any of the parties interested.
