And a panel of twenty four persons summoned by the Sheriff were examined by the Court found free from all legal exceptions and qualified to serve as jurors according to law. Thereupon the accused was called from the panel right of said jurors and from the remaining sixteen the following twelve jurors were selected by lot to whom there was no objection, to wit, Mr J Cobb, W W Branch, Orris Brambley, John C Council, Alex Branch, Ben W Sebrill, Ezra Gay, George Pond, Mr W Lawrence, J E Rove, James Council & Geo. Bradshaw who were sworn the truth of & upon the promise to speak and having heard the evidence found the following verdict to wit "We the jury find Edgar Whitehead not guilty" Therefore it is considered by the Court that he be acquitted and discharged of the housebreaking aforesaid and go thereof without day -

✓ Joe Whitehead who stands Indicted of housebreaking was set to the bar in custody of the jailor of this Court. And on the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth and for reasons appearing to the Court the trial of the said Joe Whitehead is continued till the first day of November Term next. And thereupon the said Joe Whitehead together with Calton Whitehead & Martha Whitehead his sureties herein Court, acknowledged themselves indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia as follows. the said Joe Whitehead in the sum of One hundred dollars and the said Calton Whitehead & Martha Whitehead in the like sum of One hundred dollars, to be levied of their respective goods and chattels, lands & tenements for the use of the Commonwealth, but to be void if the said Joe Whitehead shall personally appear in this Court on the first day of the next November Term, surrender himself in custody, and not depart thence without leave of this Court.
